

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

### For Class of 2014, 2015, and 2016:

All students must register for 40 credits every school year. A minimum of 140 credits must be accumulated in order to graduate.

English/Language Arts	- 4 full credit courses	20 credits
Social Studies	- 4 full credit courses	20 credits
Mathematics	- 3-4 full credit courses*	15-20 credits
Science	- 3-4 full credit courses*	15-20 credits
Health/Nutrition & Fitness	- 4 half credit courses	10 credits
World Language	- 2 full credit courses	10 credits
The Arts	- 1 half credit course	2.5 credits
Technology	- 1 half credit course	2.5 credits
Electives	- Any combination	40-60 credits

\*Each student must successfully complete at least 15 credits in both science and mathematics AND an additional 5 credits in EITHER science or math for a total of 35 credits. Accounting is considered a mathematics course for credits toward graduation requirements. It is highly recommended that all students enroll in 4 years of BOTH mathematics and science.

It is also highly recommended that all students enroll in 2 full credit courses of the same world language.

### For Class of 2017 and thereafter:

In order to graduate from North Middlesex Regional High School, a student must have earned at least 140 credits. Course requirements are the following:

English/Language Arts	- 4 full credit courses
Social Studies	- 3 full credit courses
Mathematics	- 4 full credit courses
Science	- 3 full credit courses
Physical Education	- 4 half-credit courses
World Language	- 2 full credit courses (of the same language)
The Arts	- 1 half credit course
Technology	- included as an elective
