

OLD BUSINESS

1. IHBG Home Schooling

The committee reviewed the IHBG Home Schooling policy, and Randee Rusch asked what was required for homeschooled students to receive an NM-issued diploma. Dr. Burboa-Reese said homeschooled students might receive a diploma if they had satisfied the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's competency requirements. Dr. Burboa-Reese confirmed students would need to be enrolled and attending NM for the school year they take the MCAS exam.

The committee agreed to update the policy and recommend it to the full School Committee for adoption.

The committee agreed to continue the IJL Library Material Selection and Adoption at the next meeting.

2. KHB Advertising in Schools

A discussion ensued about admission fees, and the committee agreed fees should be consistent across the district. Mr. Morgan agreed to draft an admission fee schedule and bring it to the next meeting for review and discussion.
