#### 4. Discussion of Action Items:

- Green Energy Grant David Amari said that Jim Hubert was setting up a meeting with state contacts, Rise Engineering, and some members of the AES Building Committee. More funding was released from the state, and we would need to apply by October.
- Abatement Reports/Quotes David Amari spoke with John Turner Consulting (fka Terracom), who should be sending us a quote within the month.
- Stair Tread Height Adjustment David Amari said he met with one contractor who did a site visit and is preparing a quote for the stairs and a quote for boarding windows. He also requested quotes from other contractors, but none have done a site visit yet.
- Gym Roof Drain Repair David Amari is awaiting quotes.
- New Chair Lift David Amari hopes to find more sources to quote us. The company that currently services the lift will come out to see if it's possible to repair it. The compliance certificate is still good for a year.
- Old Wing David Amari has asked for quotes on boarding the windows. The fan will be installed internally.
- Ramp/walkway rail David Nadeau will contact Ashby Building Inspector to verify that the rail is compliant.
- 5. Discussion of Multi-Year Plan: The committee reviewed the list of items to address. Discussions ensued regarding air handlers and the dumpster location. David Nadeau will inquire about moving the dumpster to a different location. The AES PTC is getting a quote for the sign and intends on potentially funding that. Clearly marked handicapped parking was added to the plan. Nancy Haines suggested adding the current action items to the plan, and June McNeil said she would do that before the next meeting.

- 7. Other business Walter Hansen inquired about the state of the boiler system while we looked into other heating options. David Amari said the concern is not so much the boiler itself but other parts of the system where he might need to access pipes for repairs which is one of the reasons we need a quote on the abatement of the tunnels. He suggested we get a second opinion on the boiler system. Walter Hansen will connect with David Amari separately on potential HVAC companies to obtain quotes from.
