- 2. June McNeil asked for input from the Committee about how frequently to meet during the summer and everyone agreed every four weeks would work better than every two weeks. June confirmed that the Ashby Elementary Building Committee's next meeting would be at 5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2023.
- 3. David Nadeau motioned, and Walter Hansen seconded the Committee vote to approve the AES Building Committee meeting minutes dated May 16, 2023, as presented.

- 4. Discussion of Action Items:
 - Oil Tank David Amari said removal will be mid-July. He is currently awaiting the Scope of Operations.
 - Green Energy Grant David Amari said that a meeting occurred with himself, Nancy Haines, Jeremy Hamond, Jim Hubert, Kelly Brown, and contacts from Montachusett Energy. He said our two grant options to apply for are: 1. \$200,000 traditional grant for mini splits, heat pumps, etc for certain sections of the building or 2. \$500,000 whole school grant for a heating solution for the entire school and we would pay 10%. He is setting a meeting with Unitil and likely Rise Engineering. He is still waiting to hear back from Ecosystems on potential options. He is also working on getting a second opinion on the current boiler system.
 - Abatement Reports/Quotes David Amari said he is still awaiting a quote from John Turner Consulting (fka Terracom). He is anticipating three quotes: left trench, right trench, full project.
 - Stair Tread Height Adjustment David Amari said he still awaiting quotes and met with one
 contractor who did a site visit and is preparing a quote for the stairs and a quote for boarding
 windows. He requested quotes from other contractors as well but none have done a site visit yet.
 - Gym Roof Drain Repair David Amari is awaiting quotes.
 - New Chair Lift Dan Johnson is contacting the company that currently services the lift to see if it's
 possible to repair.
 - Old Wing David Amari is still awaiting quotes on boarding the windows. The fan will be installed internally.
 - Ramp/walkway rail David Nadeau said the Ashby Building Inspector stated through text: "I remeasured the ramp at the elementary school. It has a one in 20 pitch which means for 20 feet, there's a 12 inch rise. This pitch constitutes a walkway and not ramp under handicap code. I find it complies with a walkway and does not require handrails. Additionally, you would have to believe that it was built in compliance when the school was originally built." Brad Morgan confirmed he has received no feedback from the state about the ADA complaint filed. David Amari suggested we obtain a written letter from the Ashby Building Inspector confirming compliance. David Nadeau will request that.
- 5. Discussion of Multi-year Plan: The committee reviewed the list of items to address. The oil tank removal was added to the list. David Nadeau noted the old police station will be removed once school is out and that the dumpsters could be moved after that.
