3. Discussion of Action Items:

- Green Energy Grant David Amari stated that the application period for the green energy grant
 was moved from October 2023 to January 2024. He is still awaiting a meeting with the state
 energy department representative, Kelly Brown, to get some questions answered. Nancy Haines
 asked about the electrical assessment from Rise Engineering and whether we would be getting a
 more comprehensive heating assessment. Discussion ensued. She noted it will need to be
 determined if we would have enough energy savings to qualify for a grant. David Amari
 mentioned he is awaiting an updated quote for the boiler.
- Abatement Reports/Quotes John Turner Consulting sent a proposal for a Scope of Operations
 for tunnel abatement of pipes and fittings, removing a layer of soil and encapsulating it. David
 Amari said Vinnie (from Turner Consulting) is estimating the actual abatement to be anywhere
 from \$40-100K. David Amari said that if we don't abate we will never be able to repair any pipes
 in the tunnels. Upon review of the proposal, the committee agreed the old wing should be
 removed from the scope of work.

David Nadeau motioned, and Anne Cromwell-Gapp seconded the Ashby Elementary School Building Committee vote to approve funds to not exceed \$4,000 out of the \$300,000 allotment to be allocated for the Scope of Work for Abatement from the point of the water room to the 1960s wing.
